

The **Eden project** provides a realistic way to create a dynamic global model for the study of cultural predisposition to the resolution of critical issues. Its approach is both simple and straightforward.

1. Identify those questions which most accurately reflect each culture's ability to frame critical issues.
2. Distill these questions into a "Global Standard for Making Inquiry into Critical Issues."
3. Employ a qualified academic to provide insight into his/her culture's position on these questions.
4. Submit this response to the power structures within each respective culture -- for review and further comments.
5. Incorporate all relevant information into a dynamic computerized data base, along with its origin.
6. Utilize this material for the study of potential solutions to existing problems.
7. Provide access to this material in as many forms as possible. (Internet, CDs, DVDs, reference books, journals, textbooks, course study guides, movies, documentaries, etc.)

The importance of having an instrument of this nature to help stabilize a World in chaotic transition cannot be overestimated, as reviewer comments indicate.
